- Initiating a Playground Project and approaching businesses with the RM of Rosser to support this project.

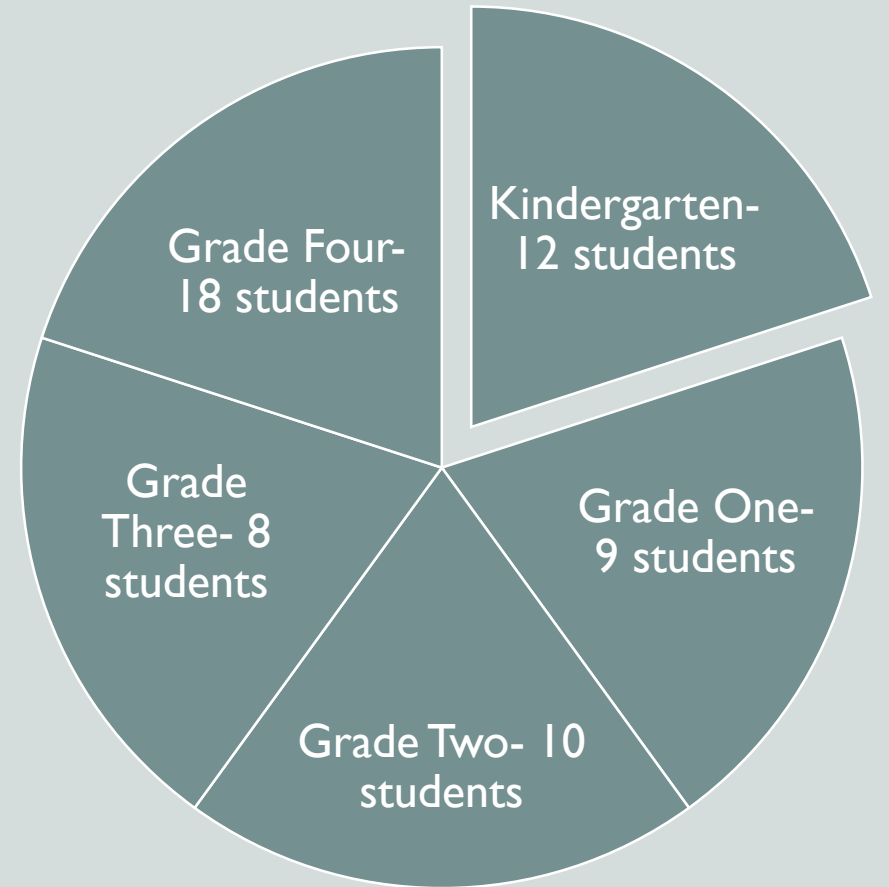

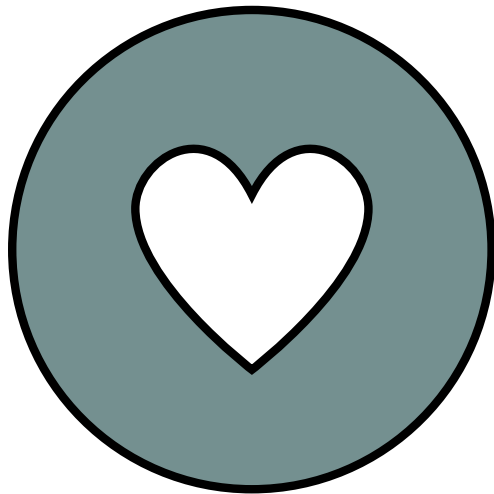
